***Step One: We admitted we were powerless over cocaine and all mind-altering substances— that our lives had become unmanageable.***

I was asked not to long ago what the most important word in this step was. I thought that it was powerless, but it is not. I have come to learn that the word *we*, is the most important. *We*— lets me know from the very start that I'm not alone, and I have many other addicts that are have been where I am. This is a very comforting idea to me.

Now on with the rest of this step. I had to admit that I was powerless over the first one and that I could not control my usage. I had to admit complete defeat and surrender before I was able to

move on and accept the fact I was an addict. *"We learned that we had to fully concede to our innermost selves that we were addicts. This is the first step in recovery. The delusion that we are like other people, or presently may be, has to be smashed."* I had to realize that I suffered from an obsession of the mind and an allergy of the body.

Then I had to realize that the unmanageability in my life was me; my thought process and the way I lived. The drugs didn't help it any, but they were not the cause of my unmanageability. I had several aspects of my life that

were out of control long before I took the first hit. This is where the rest of the steps help me to look at the patterns in my life and how to work on changing them with the help of my higher power. As time goes on and I practice this solution given to me, I start to regain some manageability in my life.

I have been given a solution to save my life, and its my choice today to use this solution and live. By the Grace of God I can admit defeat and learn to live life one day at a time without picking up! —Anonymous

***Step Two: Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity***

*"Lack of power, that was our dilemma. We had to find a power by which we could live, and it had to be a Power greater than ourselves. Obviously. But where and how were we to find this Power?"*

For me personally this step took a minute. I had grew up with a concept of God and I had a horrible resentment for God. So I wasn't even considering that he would restore me to sanity. I had to change my thinking of what a power greater than myself could be.

Thank God for sponsors.

My sponsor explained to me that a power greater than myself could be anything bigger than me. How people had used the groups as their higher power for a time until they grasp their own concept. This I could understand. I could see the groups were a power greater than me. Here was a group of people that were hopeless drug addicts, but they were living life without using and seemed relatively happy doing so. I could talk about my problems and they generally had some personal experience they could offer on how they got through a similar situation without

using. It was great and it got me through till I could deal with the resentment I had for God.

*"We needed to ask ourselves but one short question. "Do I now believe, or am I even willing to believe, that there is a Power greater than myself?" "It has been repeatedly proven among us that upon this simple cornerstone a wonderfully effective spiritual structure can be built."*
